WARNING:

- Do not attach Vehicle Frontal Protection System (**VFPS**) to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose. (e.g. engine mounting bolts)
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- The VFPS has been produced to provide continued functionality of parking sensors and other "driver assist" features as closely as possible to Original Equipment. However, as all possible road conditions and combination of other accessories fitted to the vehicle which may affect functionality characteristics cannot be anticipated, ***the driver remains responsible at all times for properly controlling the vehicle, monitoring all "driver assist" features and intervening where required to ensure the vehicle is safely operated.***

- Before installing the VFPS:
 - Check that all components, as listed in the assembly table, are available.
 - Thoroughly read all instructions.
- This product or its fasteners must not be modified in any way.
- These instructions are accurate as at the revision date and do not take into account any changes made by the vehicle manufacturer to vehicle design after the revision date or other accessories that are or have been fitted to the vehicle. Piak cannot be held responsible for such changes and appropriate enquiries should be made before installation.
- Before installing, inspecting and/or maintaining the VFPS, the work space should be safe and clear of fuel, debris, electrical or other components.
- During installation:
 - It is the responsibility of the installer to confirm correct operation/clearance of all components.
 - All holes drilled shall have all burrs and swarf removed then coated with a suitable rust preventative paint.
 - Ensure that all hardware is fastened to torque list as detailed in these instructions.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE:

To ensure continued safety and correct operation of the product, the VFPS must be routinely inspected and regularly serviced (including bolt torque checked for correct tension) by an appropriately qualified or experienced person.

The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product were used to achieve the specified rating. If replacement of the fasteners is required, fasteners of the same rating and quality must be used.

If this VFPS is fitted with a hinged number plate bracket, extra care must be taken when returning back to public roads following the use of the winch or conducting a deep water crossing.

The driver must ensure that the number plate bracket is returned back to the down position allowing full visibility of the number plate when returning to public roads.

FITTING PROCEDURE



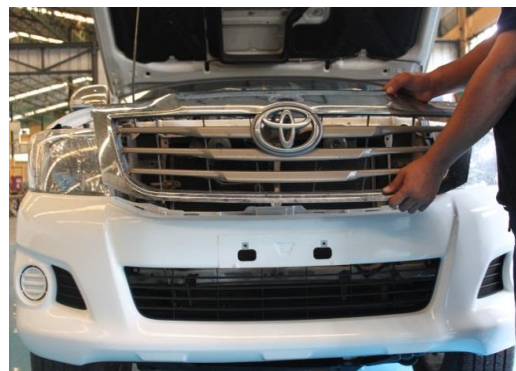
- 1 Vehicle before installation of bullbar.
Rest bullbar face down on a surface that will not scratch the bar.



- 2 Using a flat blade screwdriver to remove clip from top of grille as shown on the red circle.



- 3 Using a screwdriver to remove screw from top of grille as shown on the red circle.



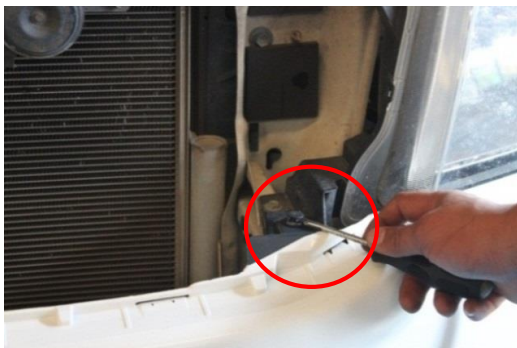
- 4 Remove the grille from vehicle and place on a soft surface.

Notice : Refer to vehicle repair manual for correct removal manual.

FITTING PROCEDURE



5 Vehicle after removed the grille out.



6 Using a flat blade screwdriver to remove clip from top of bumper as shown on the red circle.



7 Using a screwdriver to remove screw from inward of bumper as shown on the red circle.



8 Using a flat blade screwdriver to remove clip from Bottom of bumper as shown on the red circle.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 9 Using a flat blade screwdriver to remove clip from Bottom of bumper as shown on the red circle.

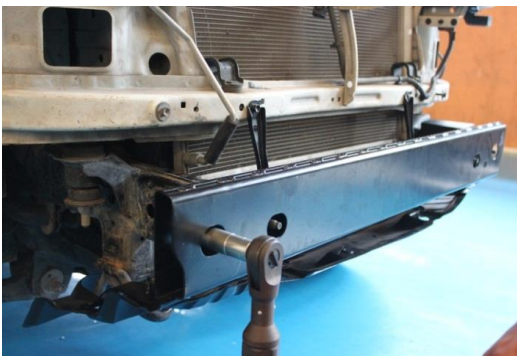


- 10 Remove the stone tray at bottom of the vehicle.



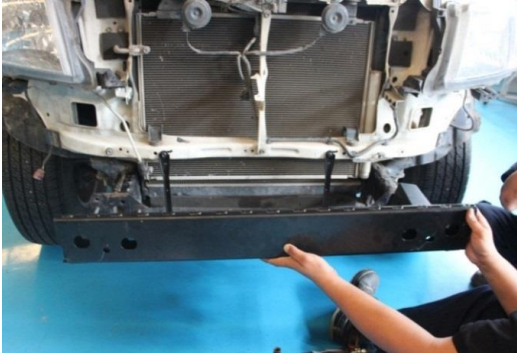
- 11 Remove the bumper from vehicle and place on a soft surface.

Notice : Refer to vehicle repair manual for correct removal manual.



- 12 Using a screwdriver to remove screw of crossbar (reinforcement beam) from front of chassis.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 13 Remove crossbar (reinforcement beam) from front of chassis and discard it.

Notice : Refer to vehicle repair manual for correct removal manual.



- 14 Remove and discard the outer bumper support brackets from either side of the vehicle.



- 15 Using a screwdriver to remove screws (red circle) that fitted plastic bracket to lower wheel arch corner and vehicle .

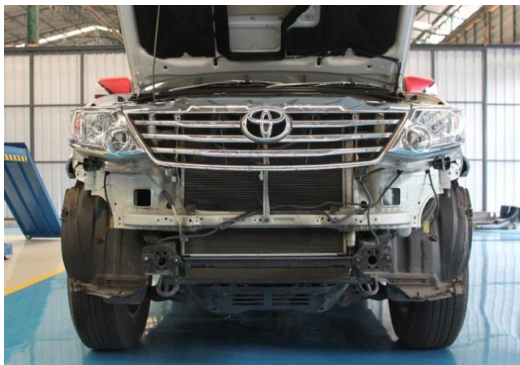
Do both sides.



- 16 Remove plastic bracket and discard it. (Red circle)

Do both sides.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 17 Reinstall grille back to vehicle with retained bolts and clips.



- 18 Fit front grille fitting bracket to front grille fitting beam in order to reinstall grille back using M6 bolt, two flat washers and flange nut.



- 19 Drilling hole for M6 for fitting front grille.



- 20 After drilling the hole on front grille, attach bracket by using M6 bolt, two flat washers, spring washer and flange nut.

FITTING PROCEDURE



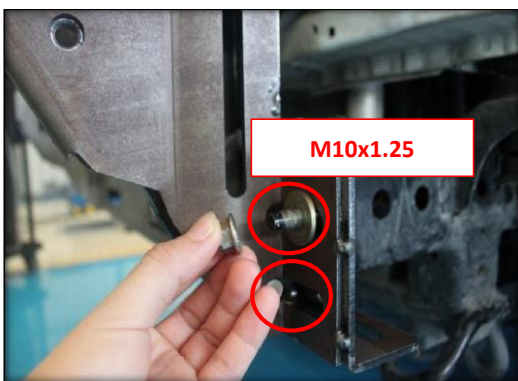
- 21 Fit the Inner Guard LH side with M6 bolts ,Spring washer ,Flash Washer and flange Nuts.



- 22 Fit the Inner Guard RH side with M6 bolts ,spring washer ,flash sasher and flange nuts.



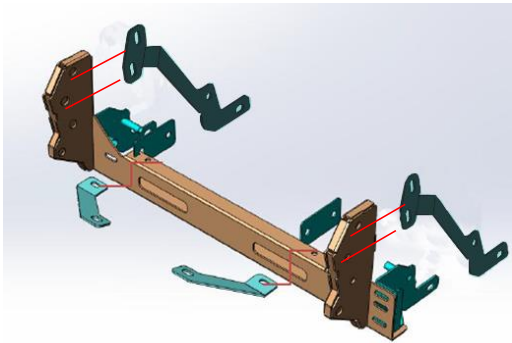
- 23 Install chassis mounting bracket to chassis of vehicle. As shown on LH side.



- 24 Fit flat washers M10 and flange nuts M10x1.25 onto the mounting bracket as shown on the red circles.

Do both side.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 25 Using two people, lift bullbar onto chassis mount bracket fitted to the chassis rail.



- 26 Fit three bolts M10x35x1.25, spring washers, flat washers and flange nuts onto the mounting bracket.

Do both side.



- 27 Fit a bolt M12x35x1.25, spring washer and flat washer onto the mounting bracket.

Do both side.



- 28 Fit Chassis Support Bracket onto the chassis by using a bolt M10x100x1.25, spring washer M10, flat washers M10, flat washer M12.

Do both side.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 29 Fit Chassis Support Spacer onto the chassis Support Bracket by using bolt M10x100x1.25, spring washer, flat washer.

Do both side.



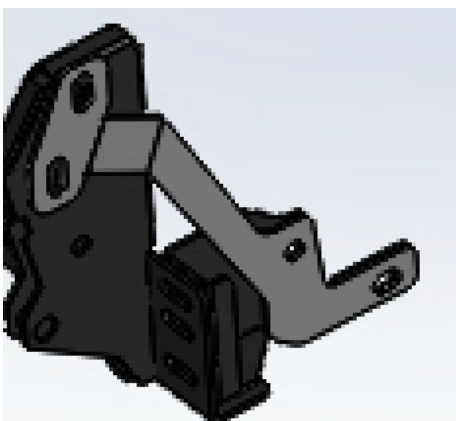
- 30 Fit bolt M12x35x1.25, spring washer, flat washer at the bottom of chassis support spacer.

Do both side.



- 31 At the rear of chassis, attach Plate Chassis with the bolts that fitted on chassis support spacer and chassis support bracket by using flat washers and flange nuts.

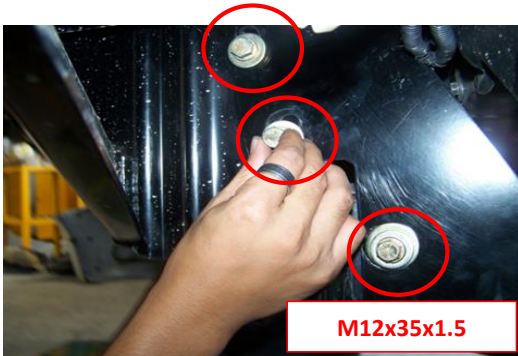
Do both side.



- 32 Attach Chassis Support Spacer onto the chassis mounting bracket.

Do both side.

FITTING PROCEDURE



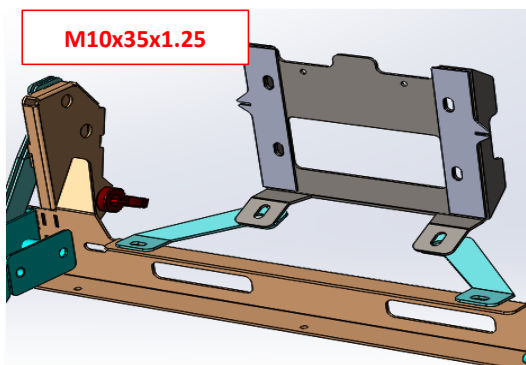
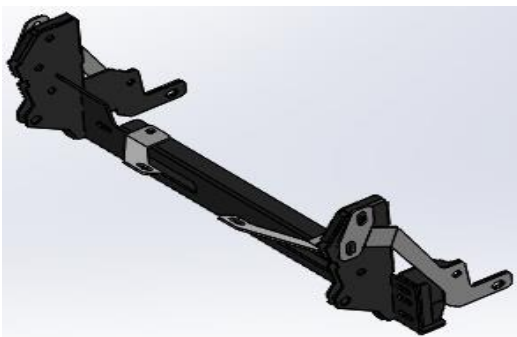
- 33 Fit bullbar bracket to chassis mounting bracket using three bolts M12x35x1.5, spring washers, flat washers as shown on the red circles.

Do both sides.



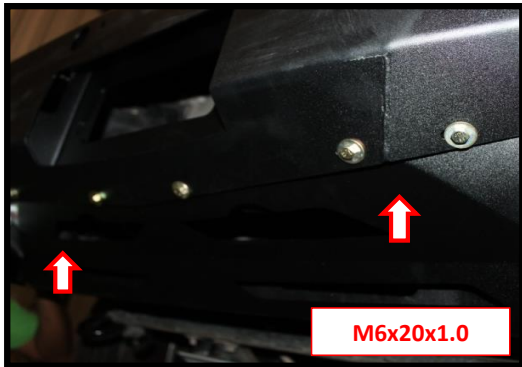
- 34 Fit winch brace onto the chassis mounting bracket by using bolt M10x35x1.25, spring washer and flat washer.

Do both side.



- 35 Fit winch brace onto sub winch bracket (red circles) at the middle of bullbar by using bolt M10x35x1.25, spring washer, flat washers and flange nuts.

FITTING PROCEDURE



- 36 Fit protection plate center to bullbar with M6 bolt kit (Spring washer , flat washer and cage nut).



- 37 Fit protection plate LH to bullbar with M6 bolt kit (Spring washer , flat washer and cage nut).

Do both side.
