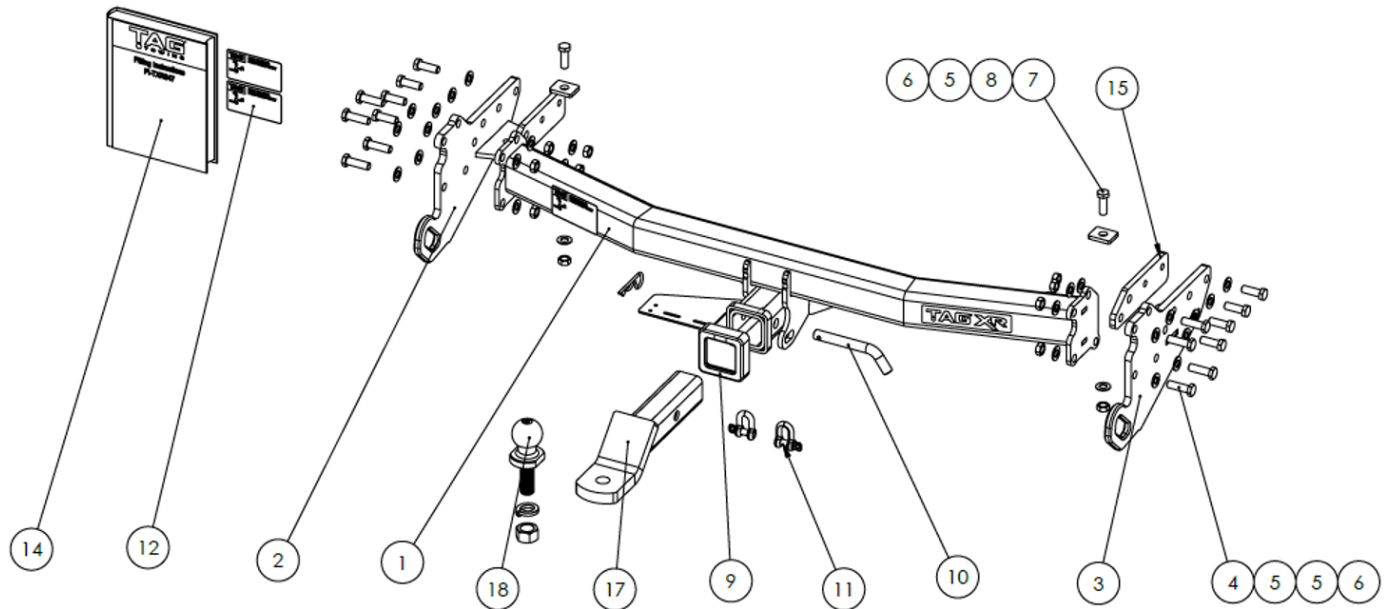

Important Information

Warning:

- This product is for towing purposes only and must only be loaded as shown in your vehicle Owner's Manual.
- This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded, or modified in any way.
- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present.
- All load ratings shown are under the assumption your trailer has a functional braking system installed.
- When installed in positions other than the one depicted in these instructions the Tow Ball Mount may interfere or obstruct certain features of your vehicle (tailgate opening, Chassis clearance, etc.)

General:

- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar. (Tray, Canopy, Suspension etc.)
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product are an integral feature to achieving the specified rating, if replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same grade (8.8) & quality are used. Contact an authorised TAG distributor or the TAG fitment center - (07) 3208 3022 - if further information is required.

Towbar Maintenance and Care:

It is recommended, when not in use, that the Tow Ball Mount assembly and class 4 Pin and Clip is stored inside the car away from moisture to prevent standing water from forming rust. Inspect to ensure, on regular basis, fasteners are torqued to the specifications below and in good condition.

Ensure that the fitting instructions are read and understood prior to fitment
Place these instructions in the vehicle's glovebox after installation is completed.

Installation Instructions

Step 1: Remove Rear Bumper

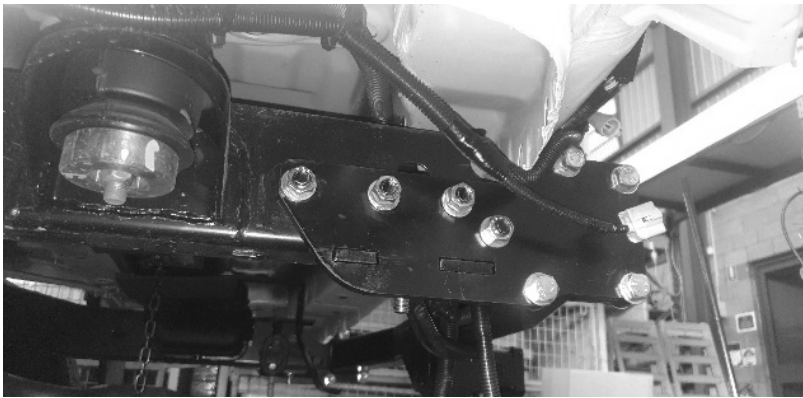
- Lift tailgate & lower spare tyre.
- Remove 3x screws from taillight assemblies (**Upper screw is behind the strut**). Pull taillight rearwards.
- Remove the tailgate stopper & plastic surround via 2x bolts.
- Remove 1x screw from the bumper.
- Repeat on opposite side.
- Remove 2x screws securing the mudflap to the wheel arch, 1x upper screw fastening the bumper to the guard and 1x screw behind the mudflap.
- Repeat on opposite side.
- Remove 2 scrivenets on the rear most underside of the bumper.
- Beginning at each wheel arch, carefully separate the bumper from the guard and remove the bumper.
- Disconnect the harness from the LHS of the vehicle.
- Remove towing/ shipping hook if fitted.



Step 2: Fit Towbar

***When fitting endplates to chassis, be aware of the lane departure radar harness attached to the body. Dislodge the fixing points from the body to prevent it from being pinched/ broken.**

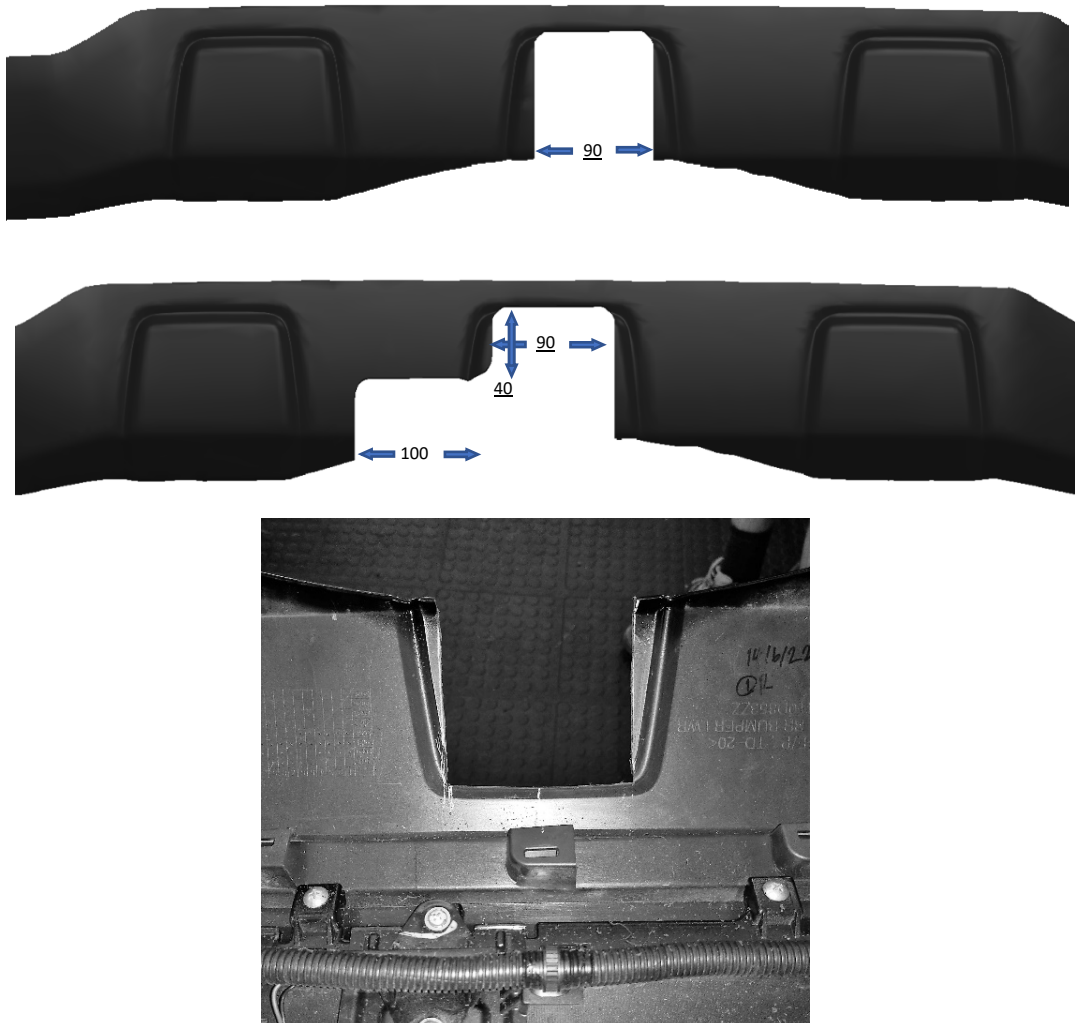
- a. Insert a large loose plate into the chassis to align with side holes.
- b. Fit end plate to chassis with 2x M12x1.25 bolts, washers & nuts into rearmost side holes. Leave loose.
- c. Insert M12x1.25 bolts with flat washers into forward most holes and fasten loosely into tapped threads of chassis plate.
- d. Insert M12x1.25 bolt with square plate down through vertical hole in chassis and loosely fasten with nut & washer.
- e. Repeat on opposite side.
- f. Lift main bar assembly up to end plates and align holes. Insert 4x M12x1.25 bolts with flat washers into each side and fasten loosely.
- g. Beginning with the chassis, tighten all bolts to the torque specification (Pg 3).



Step 3: Bumper Cut

Note: The towbar installer is ultimately responsible for the location & quality of the bumper cut. To avoid mistakes, please use the following measurements as a guide only. We suggest making small incremental cuts and regularly test fit the bumper to ensure an accurate and tidy appearance. The additional application of rubber pinch-weld around the cut edge ensures a neat & tidy look.

Establish the centre of the bumper & mark. Measure 45mm either side of the centreline. Mark the top of the cut-out at the high point of the centre bumper indent/ feature. See photo. Alternatively, use the 2nd diagram, should the customer want the trailer plug mounted to the top of the plug bracket.



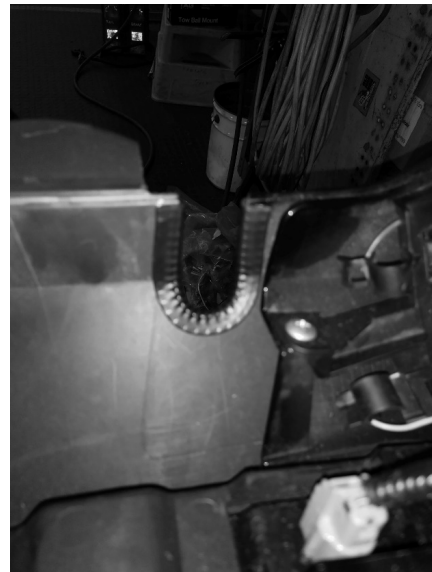
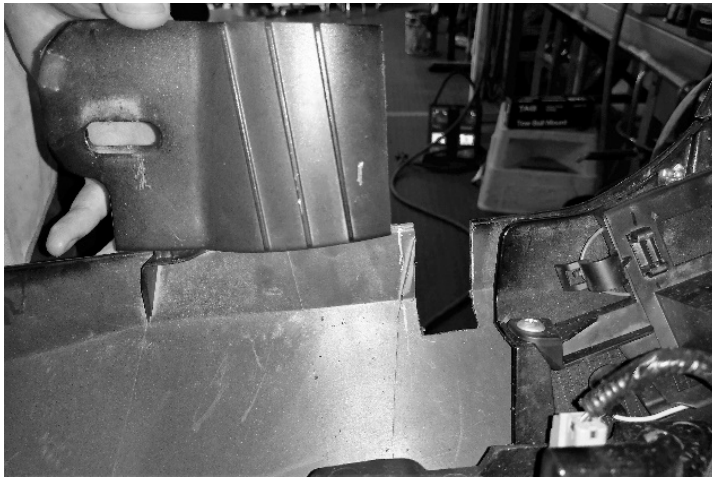
Step 3: Bumper Cut

The outer bumper must also be cut to suit the recovery eyes. Measure 525mm either side of centre and a further 25mm toward the outside. Mark the cut out 55mm in depth.

***Note: The driver's side cut-out will eliminate the outer side of the plastic exhaust shield feature. Retain the inner side as it is required to pin the bumper back to the body with the plastic scrivet.**

Using an air hacksaw or similar tool, cut the bumper. De-burr all cuts. Apply the included rubber pinch-weld to the recovery eye cut-outs and cut off any excess as close to the plastic bumper as possible.

Refit the bumper in reverse of steps 1a-j.



Step 4: Fit Ball Mount and Apply Door Sticker

- Attach plastic hitch surround to receiver.
- Insert ball mount into hitch receiver and secure with the pull pin and R-clip.
- Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door.
- Leave the remaining label & the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
